We are three athletes from Taupō selected to represent New Zealand at the 2025 Obstacle Course Racing (OCR) World Championships in Sweden.

- Laura Grant: Laura is a dedicated athlete and mother of two. She earned a Bronze medal at the 2024 OCR World Championships in Costa Rica. In 2024, Laura won Age Group (AG) Gold in the Bright Spartan Beast, AG Silver in both the Super and Sprint events, and Silver in the Beast at the APAC Spartan Championships in Fiji.
- Louisa Redward: Louisa, a mother of twins, is committed to consistent training and competition. She approaches each event with focus and perseverance.
- Xanthe Sando: Xanthe brings determination and adaptability to the team. In 2024, she achieved podium finishes at Spartan Bright, placing 3rd in both the 21km and 5km events, and 1st in the 10km. At Spartan Fiji, she secured 1st in the 10km and 2nd in the 5km. Most recently, at Spartan Bright 2025, Xanthe placed 1st in both the 10km and 5km events.

In 2024, we competed internationally, gaining valuable experience and developing our skills for the world stage. Domestically, we have participated in multiple OCR events across New Zealand and Australia, reflecting our ongoing commitment to the sport. Our training includes regular sessions at Empower Fitness, The Ninja Course at Dropzone, and on local trails. We compete both individually and as a team, demonstrating versatility and collaboration.

With OCR set to debut at the Olympics in 2028, this is a timely opportunity to support New Zealand athletes as the sport continues to grow. Supporting our team contributes to our efforts at the 2025 World Championships and may assist in developing future Olympians.





Objective

We are seeking funding to cover the costs of participating in the OCR World Championships in Sweden, September 2025. The funds will be used for:

About the Event

The 2025 OCR World Championships will take place in Gothenburg, Sweden, from 11-14 September at Slottsskogsvallen Sports Centre. The event is hosted by Tough Viking, the Swedish Athletics Federation, and Goteborg & Co. The start and finish areas will be at Slottsskogsvallen, providing a central location for participants and spectators. The event is expected to attract thousands of athletes and visitors from around the world, with competitors from 140 nations.

To qualify, we met the New Zealand Obstacle Sports Association (NZOSA) criteria, which included performance in endorsed races and meeting specific testing standards such as a sub-25-minute 5km run, a 90-second dead hang, maximum pull-ups in one minute, a single-arm dead hang of at least 10 seconds per arm, and a 1m lache.








Social Media Engagement
